

## LNCS NUMTA2019 Conference Proceedings

Authors of one-page abstracts accepted for presentation at NUMTA2019 are invited to submit their original research papers for NUMTA2019 Proceedings to be published in an [LNCS volume](#) after the Conference.

Each submitted paper can be either a short paper (min 6 – max 8 pages in the LNCS format) or a long paper (min 12 – max 15 pages in the LNCS format) and should contain an original research that has neither been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere.

All submitted papers will be regularly peer-reviewed and processed in the order received.

To be included in the LNCS Conference Proceedings, the authors should pay the registration fee. For each paper, at least one full registration fee should be paid.

Authors must be aware that after the acceptance they will be invited to submit a signed Consent to Publish form, through which the copyright of their accepted paper will be transferred to Springer.

Authors should check the “[Information for Authors of Computers Science Proceedings](#)” page, where they can download the correct templates for the preparation of their papers (the LNCS LaTeX templates are available in [Overleaf](#), as well).

Each paper should fit (in the pdf format) the required length depending on the paper type (short or long).

**EASYCHAIR SUBMISSION DETAILS** (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=numta2019>):

The pdf file of the paper has to be submitted through the [EasyChair system](#) by substituting previously submitted pdf files of abstracts with full papers as follows:

- enter in the same submission form used to submit your one-page abstract;
- to view or update your existing submission click on the corresponding "View" icon;
- click on “Update file” in the upper-right menu of the “NUMTA2019 Submission” form;
- choose your pdf-file for the Proceedings to upload;
- press “Submit” button;
- do not modify/insert any information in other fields (Title, Keywords, Authors, etc.) in the corresponding EasyChair submission form: these fields should remain the same as they were at the time of your abstract submission;
- please, notice that inside the pdf file of your paper for the Proceedings you may slightly change your titles and, in exceptional cases, to add authors.
